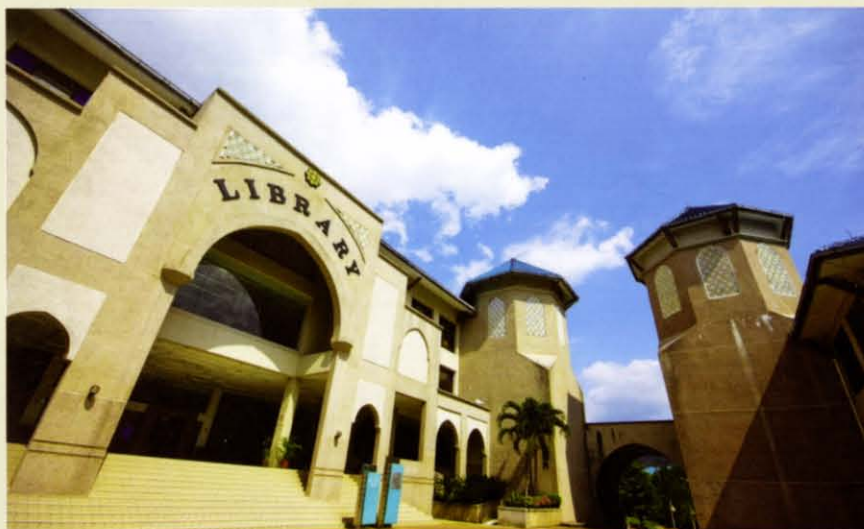


Alumni: Staying Connected with the Library

IUM graduates' connection to their alma mater can now be made much easier. As alumni, a former student can apply for the IUM Alumni Membership Card at the Alumni and Career Services Division (ACSD) office. The card will give you access to the libraries on campus, sports facilities and other discounts offered by ACSD.

To assist in the pursuit for lifelong learning, the IUM Library is pleased to continue providing IUM Alumni with library services. You can either become a mere reference member or a borrowing member. As a reference member, just display your Alumni Card to enter the library and use all the resources within the library, including the library computers to access the Library's online resources. So what should you do to become a borrowing member?

1. ESTABLISH YOUR ALUMNI ACCOUNT

To sign up for an alumni account, register yourself at the Library's Circulation Counter. Fill in the Membership Form and attach to it the copies

of your IC/passport and your Alumni Card. You will need to pay an annual fee of RM300 upon registration. Within one working day or sometimes within a few minutes your registration is activated and you can start borrowing books.

2. BORROWING PRIVILEGES

As a paid registered member, you can start borrowing books. You are allowed to borrow 5 books for the duration of 2 weeks. All transactions can be done at the Circulation Counter or through the Self-check Machines. Access to online collections like the online databases and digital library collection, however, needs to be done within campus only due to the restrictions in the databases' license agreement.

3. ON-SITE SERVICES

Alumni may use the IUM Library until the closing time. It is advisable that you access the library homepage at HYPERLINK *<http://www.iium.edu.my/lib>*<http://www.iium.edu.my/lib> to view the latest opening hours before coming to the

campus. To use the Library's computers, request for a quest password at the Reader's Advisory Desk. You are able to use the computers for two hours per-password. This will then allow you to use the Library's online databases and Digital Library services. Printing and photocopying are also available within the Library.

Just as IUM will always be special to its graduates, alumni are people that the Library will always hold dear.
